

## Conversation Analysis on Sing 2 Movie

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**Abstract:** The research aims to describe types of aspects in Conversation Analysis on Sing 2 movie and to show the most occurrence of conversation aspects found in Sing 2 movie. This study focuses on the analysis that directs the explanation of the conversation aspects in Sing 2 movie. The research method used in this research is qualitative method. The data collection of this research employs purposive sample. Meanwhile, source of data in this research is taken from website m.imdb.com. Furthermore, the data is analyzed by using a theory proposed by Paltridge (2012). The results of the research most used is turn-taking. The number of turn-taking indicate that there are 293 turns.

### RESEARCH BACKGROUND

Movie is a fictional narrative in prose or verse and an imaginative work. Movie can also popular entertainment, a product produced and marketed by a major commercial studio, technician. The finished product, which takes about two hours, will first be shown in cinemas; it eventually appears on DVD and Blu-ray, streaming, download or payperview and finally ends up on TV. movie can we know on series of moving images recorded with sound, telling a story, to be shown on television or in a movie theater or cinema (Minderop, 2005, p. 1; USA: W.W. Conversation is a form of cooperative activity in the form of communicative interaction. Meanwhile, it was also explained that conversation is a form of discourse that involves two or more actors who contribute to each other and where the joint activity involves two or more participants using linguistic forms and nonverbal signals to communicate interactively. This Conversation Analysis is interesting to identify and research because it plays an important role in the field of conversation. The researcher chose this title because it is related to the language in which the conversation in the film contains a spirit that is packaged in the form of a musical conversation and can be identified and explained clearly, and describes what the expectations and actual intentions are used by the participants.

Moreover, watching the movie “Sing 2” makes the writer wondered how aspects of conversation analysis are applied in each conversation. Thus, the author arranges some research questions as below: What aspects are used most often and rarely in the movie “Sing 2 Movie”?

## **REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE**

In the analysis of conversations on this kind of interaction, conversations can be analyzed in discourse analysis. Paltridge (2012:1) states that discourse analysis is an approach to language analysis that appears in language patterns across texts but because of the social and cultural context in which the text occurs. Paltridge (2012:2) Discourse Analysis also considers the ways that the used of language presents different views of the world and different understandings.

### **Aspects of Discourse Analysis**

Aspects of Conversational interactions that have been examined from this perspective include conversational opening and closing, turn taking, adjacency pairs, preference organization, feedback.

#### **1. Opening and Closing**

Opening in this conversation the announcer opens the conversation by saying whois on the line and what the conversation will be about. The closing is made up of two further units such as ‘bye bye’ and ‘good bye’. In this closing both speakers mutually negotiate the end of the conversation.

#### **2. Turn Taking**

The basic rule in english conversation is that one person speaks a time. After which they may nominated another speaker or another speaker may take up the turn without being nominated (sacks et al 1947:sacks 2004).

#### **3. Adjacency pairs**

Adjancency pairs are utterance produced by two successive speakers in a way that the second utterance is identified as related to the first one as an expected follow up to that utterance.

#### **4. Preferance Organization**

The basic rule for adjacency pairs, then is that when a speaker produces a first pair part that should stop taking and allow the other speaker to produce a second pair part.

#### **5. Feedback**

Feedback that is the ways is which listeners show they are attending to what is being said this can be done.
